When I was told I would be working with Agape to take the next step in breaking my homeless cycle, I thought it would just be a group who would pay my bills while I blindly powered forward hoping for a good end result. I am so happy and blessed to say that was the least of what they did!

Yes, they paid for my housing costs, but they also loved and nurtured the parts of me that money couldn't care for. I had asked for hand me down houseplants to make my home feel special and Agape House went above and beyond what I expected—bringing 9 beautiful houseplants that made our apartment feel like a home. They brought food from Trader Joe's each week, giving us new foods to try—making cooking in our home fun and eating with my daughter such a beautiful thing. I was also lucky to get a mentor who has become a friend. She helped me map out priorities (like paying debts, getting insurance and preparing for taxes) but she also spoke to me emotionally and helped me to grow as a woman, a mother and a daughter of God. She helped me want to get back to living my life.

I can't thank Agape House enough for not only helping me get "back on my feet" but for genuinely loving me in a way that made me feel worthy as a person who was excited to embrace this new chapter in my life. I am ready to take back my life because of what Agape House did for me.
