

Whistleblower Policy

If an employee, volunteer or board member has a reasonable suspicion of violations of the Agape House of Prescott's Code of Ethics; including illegal acts, waste, fraud or abuse of funds; it must be reported to the Executive Director or a board member immediately. The report will be kept confidential to the extent possible to allow for an adequate investigation. The report will be investigated and addressed appropriately, depending on the facts and circumstances. Depending upon the nature of the allegation, the Board of Directors may wait until the next scheduled board meeting to place the matter as an item on the agenda for discussion or may call an emergency or electronic meeting. The whistleblower individual will not be retaliated against for making a report in good faith.
